## 2010 "Ringers" Kick-Off Tournament

④ February 20 & 21

Sign up as an individual or a 2-person team in the pro shop.

- SMGA, MGA, LGA
- Best-Ball Net over two days
- Designate tee selection at sign-up
- Prizes for top three low scores and #1 low score on Day 1
- Closest-to-the-pin on both days
- Dinner Friday night and lunch on Sunday
  - Cash Bar

### "Ringers" Format

Open to all MGA, SMGA & LGA Members! (Members must have paid 2010 dues.)

- ① Two-person teams. (Sign up as a team OR singles will be paired via a secret formula.)
- ② Best-ball 'net' (100% handicap) over two days. Example: a) A player's net eagle on Day 1/Hole #1 will apply, for the team, unless that score is improved upon on Day 2. b)



Should both players record a net double bogey (or worse) on Day 1/Hole #2, that score may be improved upon (ideally significantly) on Day 2 and represent the final score.

③ Blue tee players (or white or red) are encouraged to participate (in any combination) and standard PGA – mixed-tee tournament rules will apply, ie. gold handicaps will be static, blue handicaps are decreased by 2 strokes, white handicaps decreased by 5 and red handicaps decreased by 1.

④ Prizes will be awarded to the top 3 final low total scores (tiebreaker determined by retrogression; 2-day low single net score beginning with handicap hole #1, then #2,3,4...) and to the #1 low score on Day 1.

⑤ Nearest-to-the-pin pro shop credit prizes on both days. Gold, blue & white tees will be positioned together on all par 3's. Two per day for men. One daily for ladies. (Note: there are 2 'groups' of men playing and 1 ladies.)

⑥ Dinner on Friday night and Sunday lunch included. Cash bar. Dinner: Asian stir fry, rice, salad, wings & desert. Lunch: deli platter, pasta salad, chips & brownies.

⑦ Cost will be \$80 which includes food, carts & prizes. (Golf fees will apply to non-club members.) Same cart fee / food charge as last year; prize pool increased from \$7 per player to \$11.) Spouses attending Friday dinner will be charged an additional \$22.25. This format has proven itself to be quite popular at other clubs and will provide a fun, relatively low-pressure start to our season.
